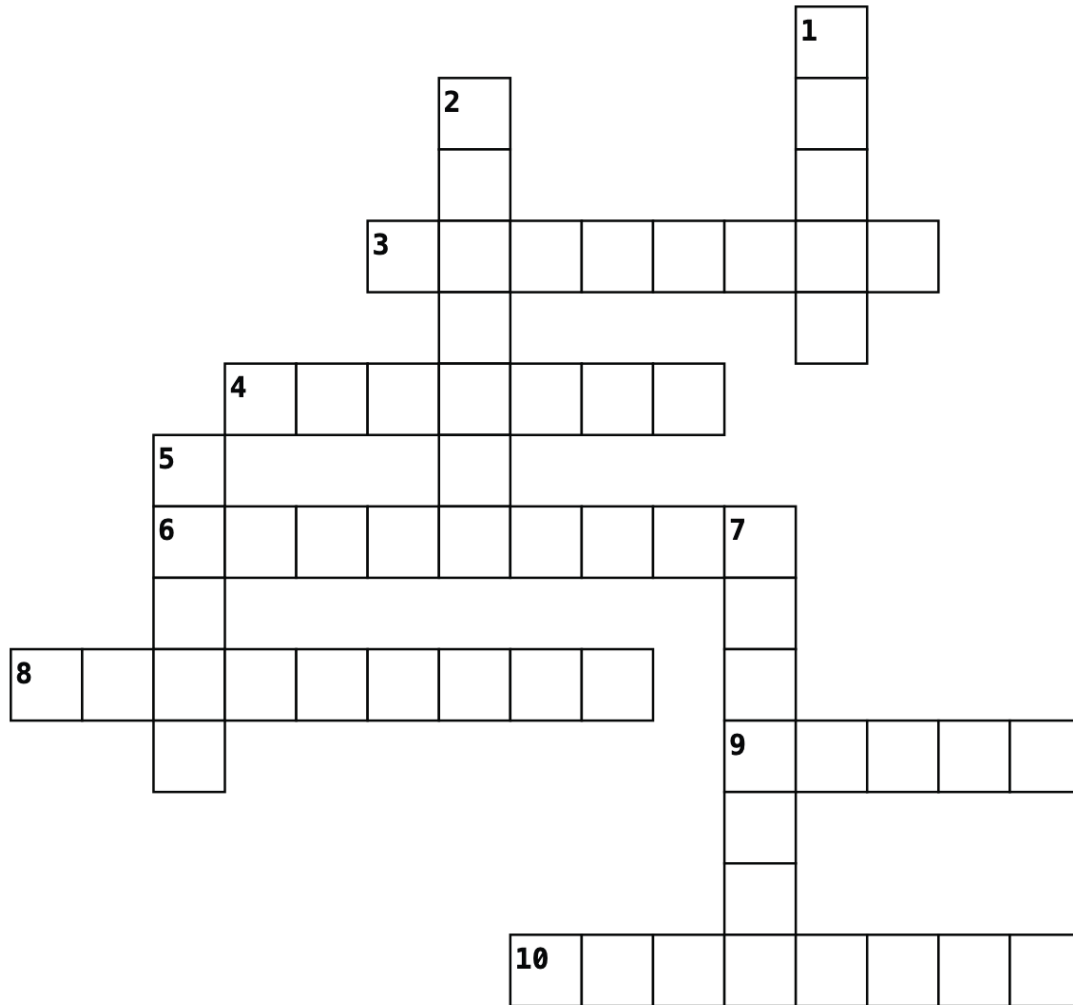


St. Martin Sea Life Crossword!
